Tenebrae Service at 7:00 pm

A service of preparation for the beginning of the Easter Triduum on Holy Thursday. Bishop Joseph Siegel will be present and preach the evening service.

Night Prayer to Close Adoration in the Sacred Heart Chapel: 11:50 pm

**Adoration will end at midnight on Wednesday. According to Church Law, Perpetual Adoration “pauses” during the Easter Triduum, and resumes AFTER the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday. The Chapel is CLOSED.*

April 1st ~ Holy Thursday

Morning Prayer: 8:00 am

Evening Mass of the Lord’s Supper at 7pm [*The Easter Triduum begins*]

Night Prayer to Close Adoration in the Sacred Heart Chapel: 11:50 pm

**Solemn Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament begins after the evening Mass, and ends at Midnight.*

April 2nd ~ Good Friday

Morning Prayer: 8:00 am

Afternoon Service of the Lord’s Passion with Holy Communion at 3pm

Stations of the Cross presented by Holy Trinity Youth Ministry: 7:00 pm

April 3rd ~ Holy Saturday

Morning Prayer: 8:00 am

Blessing of the Easter Food: Noon
