

Chapel Conduct

1. Remember that you are in the holy presence of God.
2. Dress appropriately; clean, modest, and respectful. Remember that the temperature in the chapel could fluctuate – bring a sweater. Of course, short visits on the way home from work are always welcome...*work attire*, welcome!
3. Adoration is a peaceful and quiet time for each adorer. The chapel should be silent at all times; therefore, there should be no talking, including audible individual prayer. Please maintain an austere reverence in the presence of the Lord. If you need to talk, please leave the chapel and do so in the vestibule.
4. Food, gum, candy or drink (including water bottles) are not allowed in the chapel.
5. No cell phones, cd or tape players, ipods or radios are to be used in the chapel.
6. Nothing is to be placed on the altar, by the statues, or anywhere else in the chapel, unless approved by the priests of Holy Trinity. All requests are to be directed through the rectory office.
7. No written material of any kind is to be placed in the chapel, unless approved by the priests of Holy Trinity. All requests are to be directed through the rectory office. Unsolicited materials will be promptly removed.
8. The spiritual reading material, prayer books, and Bibles provided in the chapel are not to be removed from the chapel.
9. The chapel telephone is for emergency use only.
10. No flowers, candles, decoration, etc. of any kind may be placed in/around the chapel. Unsolicited items will be promptly removed.
11. Restrooms for chapel use are located in the lobby of the Mother of Life Wing --- use the west door in the vestibule, restroom is located to your left as you leave the chapel.

***Please note:** If you leave the chapel to use the restroom during the night hours (when the chapel doors are locked and secured) **take your key card with you** – or, remember the code to re-enter. The door will lock behind you when you enter the lobby of the Mother of Life Wing.
