The 5<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> Grade French and Spanish students model Christ like behavior, reaching out to the less fortunate through their volunteer time at Feed My Starving Children. The students prepared well in advance for their production time at the Aurora facility. They spent several weeks examining the culture and geography of the African and Latin American countries that receive food relief from the FMSC organization. They studied the common villages with people in greatest need.

To prepare linguistically for their experience, they studied the key phrases in each target language that would be used in their groups to pack food boxes. They prepared themselves to call out items that they needed from their packing team in French or Spanish.

The students created French and Spanish t- shirts to keep themselves focused on the task at hand... saving as many lives as possible by packing as much as time allows. They placed phrases and flags with country names on their t- shirts, this helped them focus on the need throughout the world.

Finally, students collected a number of items included on the FMSC wish list. These are donations that help keep the volunteer organization functioning. They collected items for a week, and arrived for duty with bags of items for the facility. The students walked away from their donation of time that chilly day in November knowing that lives will be extended because of their efforts!!
